- 1. PT's with no previous Acupuncture experience. Under high standards of teaching & examination they learn to confidently apply needling into their practice immediately.
- 2. PT's with some or extensive Acupuncture experience. They learn additional practical techniques and point combinations and re-enforce knowledge previously acquired.



Also, based on the College of Physiotherapists of Ontario regulations, Physiotherapists can apply acupuncture immediately after taking the APTEI ADN courses upon the successful completion of the assessment of knowledge and skills following each course.



SPDN is an effective motor point needling technique used with or without an Acupen for the purpose of pain reduction, tissue healing and muscle lengthening.



The ADN program also incorporates **electro-acupuncture**, **acupressure and cupping**, **which focus on stimulating "Chi"** in order to promote a healing response. In addition, we offer ongoing mentorship through email and telephone calls.
